UNIFORM POLICY

We feel consistency is a critical thing to try and achieve for all of our pupils. The intention of the uniform policy is to avoid unnecessary confrontations at the start of the day with pupils who are not dressed in accordance with our very basic school uniform policy. The wearing of correct uniform is discussed at the initial meeting and is also addressed in the pupil enrolment booklet all parents sign prior to their child starting at the school.

Pupils must wear

- **Black trousers/skirt**
- **Plain socks/tights**
- **School embroidered Polo Shirt**
- **School embroidered Hoody**
- **Black shoes**

No leggings, jeggings or casual trousers will be allowed unless there is medical evidence that the pupil has a sensory issue.

If pupils who are on roll with Shepwell have any sensory requirements can you please liaise directly with Mrs Bloomfield or Miss Gibbs, we will discuss individual needs.

The school polo shirt/t-shirt and hoody can be purchased from the school priced at £30 for 2 Shirts and 1 hoody. Payments' can be made by using the online platform ParentPay.

Jewellery

Jewellery of any description is not encouraged and is not practical for many reasons. A flat, plain ring and one pair of small, plain stud or sleeper size earrings and a watch are the only items allowed. All Jewellery is brought into school entirely at the pupil's own risk.

Nose studs and all other types of piercing are not allowed. Pupils will be required to remove any items of jewellery which contravenes this code; they will be confiscated until parents collect them from school.

Make Up

Make up of any description is discouraged. Pupils will be required to remove any excessive make up. Nail varnish is not allowed. False nails are not allowed.

If you do decide to allow your child to have additional piercings please ensure that they are removed for school. This will be strictly enforced and pupils not correctly attired for lessons will not be allowed to attend lessons until the issue has been fully resolved. I should stress that this is absolutely the last thing we want as a school as we all place great emphasis on good attendance to school and to lessons.

I would be grateful if you could ensure your son/daughter is properly dressed for school.

We are very proud of our school and of our pupils and believe that high standards of uniform, behaviour, being properly equipped and attending regularly give each and every one of our pupils the very best chance of learning well and achieving their very best. Thank you all very much in advance of your anticipated support and understanding.

On collection of the Shepwell uniform you will be asked to sign the School Uniform Agreement which is as follows:

Shepwell School have provided (Pupil) with a school uniform on the (DATE)

- **In order to have use of this uniform I will support my child in keeping the uniform clean and ready to use.**

- **I will discuss the importance of wearing the uniform with my child at home.**

- **I understand that if my child attends school in non-uniform they will be issued with a consequence, meaning my child will be placed in 'reflection' until they choose to wear the correct uniform to school.**

- **I understand that I can speak to staff members regarding uniform at any time and issues will be resolved in collaboration.**
